Thought: Being Certain in your Uncertainty

Special Reading: Psalm 24, Psalm 34

Scripture: Malachi 3:6- For I am the Lord, I change not;...

Joshua 1:9- Have not I commanded thee? Be strong and of a good courage; Be not afraid, neither be thou dismayed: for the Lord thy God is with thee whithersoever thou goest.

As we move through life, I challenge you to be certain in your uncertainty. The pendulum of time can change in a moment. What you thought, what you dreamed, where you were traveling, walking, all can change without notice. We control nothing. The times we live in are so full of uncertainty.
