Thought: The Harvest is Now

Readings: Matthews 9: 37-38; Matthews 28:19-20; Mark 4:26-29

Scripture: John 4: 35 *Say not ye, There are yet four months, and then cometh harvest? be hold, I say unto you, Lift up your eyes, and look on the fields; for they are white already to harvest.*

Matthews 9: 38 *Pray ye therefore the Lord of the harvest, that he will send forth labourers into his harvest.*

The harvest is now. The scriptures let us know the fields are ripe for picking. Consider the farmer and how he prepares for his harvest. Once he plants his crop, he begins to make preparation for the harvest. He determines what he needs to bring that crop to market. He begins getting ready for the harvest. As saints of God, it's our job to harvest the lost souls into the heavenly kingdom. We are the labourers that Jesus has commanded to go forth and be his witnesses.

Each of us has the mandate to tell others about the saving grace and mercy of our risen Lord, Jesus Christ. Lost souls need to hear from you.
