Thought: Feed My Sheep

Scripture: John 21:16- He saith to him again the second time, Simon son of Jonas, lovest thou me? He saith unto him, yea Lord; thou knowest that I love thee. He saith unto him, Feed my sheep.

Jesus spoke to Simon (Son of Jonas, named Peter) asking the question, do you love me? Jesus is asking you and me the same question. Do you love me? We are challenged as Peter was to “feed my sheep”.

As believers in Jesus Christ, we are to share with others the life-giving power of the Word of God. To feed implies the giving of food, the giving of something that will nourish, something that will sustain life.
