CAN YOU HEAR GOD?

READINGS: *John 7:40*

SCRIPTURE: *Matthew 13:9- Who hath ears to hear, let him hear.*

Saints, not everyone is open to the things of God. Not everyone will hear the words that we speak to him or her. Not everyone has a mind turned to Jesus Christ. The bible says that there will be those whose hearts are hardened to the things of God. They first will not understand spiritual things (*Mat. 13:15*). Does that mean that you failed when you talked to someone and they can't see what you're telling them about Jesus? No, it just means they are not ready to receive God's word. You are there to plant the seed, someone else may come along and water that seed (*Mat. 13*).

The word of God will accomplish what God has assigned for it to do. *Isaiah 55:11* *So shall my word be that goeth forth out of my mouth: it shall not return unto me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper in the thing whereto I sent it.* Remember, when you meet those who say there is no God, the Bible says they are fools (*Psalms 14:1*).
